Existing single-family dwellings shall be provided with Carbon Monoxide Alarms no later than July 1, 2011

When the valuation of additions, alterations, or repairs to existing dwelling units exceeds \$1,000.00, Section(s) R314 and R315 of the California Residential Code require that Smoke Alarms and/or Carbon Monoxide Alarms be installed in the following locations:

1. Outside of each separate dwelling unit sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedroom(s).
 - Smoke Alarm and Carbon Monoxide Alarm
2. On every level of a dwelling unit including basements
 - Smoke Alarm and Carbon Monoxide Alarm
3. Within each sleeping room
 - Smoke Alarm

Carbon Monoxide Alarms are not required in dwellings which do not contain fuel-burning appliances and do not have an attached garage.

Multi-purpose alarms: Carbon monoxide alarms combined with smoke alarms shall comply with Section R315.1 and shall be approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall.

Power Supply: In dwelling units with no commercial power supply, alarm(s) may be solely battery operated. In existing dwelling units, alarms are permitted to be solely battery operated where repairs or alterations do not result in the removal of wall and ceiling finishes or there is no access by means of attic, basement or crawl space. See Sections R314.5 and R315.1. An electrical permit is required for alarms which must be connected to the building wiring.

As owner of the above-referenced property, I hereby certify that the alarm(s) referenced above has/have been installed in accordance with the manufacturer’s instructions and in compliance with the California Residential Code. The alarms have been tested and are operational.
