CITY OF WOODLAKE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

WOODLAKE, CA – The State of California Department of Public Health has approved all Cities and unincorporated areas in the County of Tulare to move to Stage 2 of California’s roadmap.

Below is the list of activities/sectors that fall within Stage 2. These activities/sectors are opened with modications.

- Manufacturers
- Logistics
- Childcare for those outside of the essential workforce
- Office-based businesses (telework remains strongly encouraged)
- Select services: car washes, pet grooming and landscape gardening
- Outdoor museums, open gallery spaces and other public spaces with modifications
- Destination retail (retail stores), including shopping malls and swap meets
- Dine-in restaurants
- Limited-capacity religious services and cultural ceremonies

The following activies/sectors are NOT permitted in Stage 2.

- Personal services such as nail salons, tattoo parlors, gyms and fitness studios
- Indoor museums, kids museums and gallery spaces, zoos and libraries
- Community centers, including public pools, playgrounds, and picnic areas
- Nightclubs
- Concert venues
- Live audience sports
- Festivals
- Theme parks
- Hotels/lodging for leisure and tourism – non-essential travel

For those sectors that may have County or State licenses please contact your licensing office if you need further clarification. As the situation surrounding the COVID-19 coronavirus continues to develop locally and around the globe, the City of Woodlake remains committed to protecting and preserving the health and safety of our community and residents as our highest priority.
